



American Intelligence Since 9/11

Our speaker for the 2nd Annual President's Speakers Series is **General Michael V. Hayden**, one of the nation's foremost intelligence experts and former director of both the U.S. Central Intelligence Agency and the National Security Agency.

General Hayden was director of the NSA from 1999 to 2005, working to put a human face on the former highly secretive agency and making it more visible and transparent on the national scene.

As head of the CIA from 2006 to 2009, he oversaw the collection of information on the intentions and capabilities of America's adversaries, producing timely analyses for the country's top decision makers and conducting covert operations to thwart terrorists and other enemies of the United States.

Between those two assignments, he served for one year as our nation's first principal deputy director of national intelligence and the top U.S. military intelligence officer.

In his nearly 40 years in the Air Force, General Hayden rose to the rank of four-star general. He commanded the Air Intelligence Agency and directed the Joint Command and Control Warfare Center. He also served in senior staff positions at the Pentagon, the U.S. European Command, on the National Security Council staff in the White House, and at the U.S. Embassy in Bulgaria. Other posts included deputy chief of staff for the United Nations Command and U.S. Forces in South Korea.

He currently is a principal at the Chertoff Group, a global corporate advisory firm focused on the security and risk management sectors.

General Hayden has been a frequent commentator on major news outlets and in top publications, valued for his expertise on intelligence matters such as cyber security, government surveillance, and geopolitics. He was featured in the HBO documentary *Manhunt*, about the search for Osama bin Laden, and Showtime's *The Spymasters*, a detailed look at CIA directors.

His recent memoir, *Playing to the Edge: American Intelligence in the Age of Terror*, is a New York Times best-seller.

General Hayden graduated from Duquesne University with a bachelor's degree in history in 1967 and a master's degree in modern American history in 1969. He is a distinguished visiting professor at George Mason University in Virginia.
