William P. Kiehl is the President and CEO of PD Worldwide, consultants in international public affairs, higher education management and cross-cultural communications.

During a 33-year career in the U.S. Foreign Service Dr. Kiehl served as the Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary, Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs of the U.S. Department of State and in numerous public diplomacy positions at home and abroad. Since leaving the diplomatic service he has taught public diplomacy at the Foreign Service Institute and has lectured at a number of colleges and universities.

He served as Diplomat-in-Residence at the U.S. Army War College's Center for Strategic Leadership as Senior Fellow of the U.S. Army Peacekeeping Institute.

He was also Executive Director of the Public Diplomacy Council at the School of Media and Public Affairs, George Washington University after serving as Treasurer and member of the Council's Board.

He is editor *emeritus* of the on-line journal *American Diplomacy*, affiliated with the University of North Carolina and currently serves as the journal's books editor.

He retired from the diplomatic service with the rank of Minister-Counselor in 2003. He holds a doctorate in Higher Education Management from the University of Pennsylvania. Kiehl earned an honors degree from the University of Scranton and an M.A. in Foreign Affairs from the University of Virginia.

He is the author of numerous articles and book chapters on foreign affairs and public diplomacy and the book *Global Intentions/Local Concerns*. He is the editor of three other books, *America's Dialogue with the World*, *The Eagle and the Elephant*, and *The Last Three Feet*.
